<b>TOPIC:</b>	<b>REPORT/DISCUSSION:</b>	<b>ACTION:</b>
CALL TO ORDER:	The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. and opened with a prayer led by Clay Aumann.	
APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES AND AGENDA:	The March 25, 2014 St. Jude Pastoral Council meeting minutes were approved as submitted.  The meeting agenda was approved as distributed with one addition under Old Business: Mass Intentions.	
NEW BUSINESS:	There was no new business to discuss.	
<b>OLD BUSINESS:</b>		
RENOVATIONS:	Approximately \$151,000 has been pledged toward the proposed renovation projects. The first phase of the renovations will be replacement of the windows in the church, which should begin shortly after the St. Jude-St. Patrick Parish Picnic. It will still be possible to have Mass in the church during this project.	Informational; no council action required at this time.
CONVENT:	The charismatic group that rents space in the Annunciation school building will need to vacate that area by July 1 <sup>st</sup> . The group has been offered some rooms in the former St. Jude Convent, but they are still considering their options. They have narrowed their selections to either this convent space or relocation to St. Peter and Paul Parish.	Informational; no council action required at this time.
PARISH LIFE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Council members indicated they have not heard any comments recently regarding the proposed renovation projects. A second letter was sent to all parish households, similar to the initial letter but with bolded sentences providing updated information. The second mailing was intended to remind those who have not returned pledge forms to do so, and also to share progress on the campaign with those who had submitted their forms while also offering another opportunity to consider an additional donation. If the response to the second mailing is not successful in securing more funds, a third letter may be required.</li> <li>• The recent cribbage tournament was very successful, bringing in \$4200.</li> </ul>	Informational; no council action required at this time.
MASS INTENTIONS:	Council members questioned the policy for sharing Mass intentions when a specific date is requested and another party has already scheduled that Mass. It was clarified this matter is subject to Canon law so it is not possible to establish individual parish policies. If more than one person wants to schedule an intention for the same Mass, the person who first scheduled the Mass can be contacted and asked to share the service but that person cannot be required to do so.	No council action required.
