**Lenten considerations:** Rather than following the original plan of having a Holy Hour each week along with Stations of the Cross to be done once at each parish, the calendar is being revised so that Holy Hours will be interspersed with Stations. We will have Stations of the Cross every other week during Lent. On the weeks that we don't have Stations we will offer a Holy Hour in the evening.

Next meeting we will discuss ideas of a Lenten theme.

The Lenten Calendar will be updated to reflect the changes in schedule.

**Communicating Lenten events:** there was a general discussion of the best ways to communicate what's going on to parishioners. Suggestions offered included post cards, email reminders, and reminder apps.
