## Easter people - ordinary family in unordinary time

This New Year's resolution was to un-busy myself; declutter my life, and big steps were in place for this spring! I did not make the resolution because I wanted to get rid of things that I did not care for, I made the resolution so that all of the things that I care for could have the most fulfillment in the time I have to give. It seemed like a great plan; to slowly deliberate on what was keeping me too busy, to choose what to focus on, and to discern how to move forward with my family life & ministry. I was determined & filled with joy to realize this year's resolution!

I was looking forward to this spring for a long time. Certain things were about to run their course, like, my Emmaus classes had concluded early in the year and my graduation was set for May, so I didn't have any more homework or day long classes to add into our family schedule. (Yay!) The projects that had been slated for "the next free day" were going to be marked off the list, like cleaning out the closet of doom. (Every house has at least one.) It was happening! Then, we left for spring break.

Our trip was to Florida in early March, with the last few days of the trip littered by news of a virus. Before leaving to return home, we had asked a family member to shop for groceries for us, out of conscientiousness for others. The airports already showed evidence of growing concern as a few people were already wearing gloves and masks. We arrived home to a stocked refrigerator and two weeks of self quarantine for safety's sake...the weeks that followed have been much the same, which made for a very empty calendar and a very prominent opportunity for checking off things on the to-do list.

We have been fortunate, in that the adjustments we made; coping with the changes we faced was not difficult. The kids have been schooling from home at the kitchen table, with their teachers communicating assignments digitally. (HUGE shout out to all the teachers, but especially to the educators at HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL for all of the ways that they have

made this a great experience for the kids.) They have been connecting with their friends through technology, digital classrooms, playing games online together, helping one another with homework, and talking. There is still a balance to strike with screen time & technology, but we want to encourage them to stay connected with their friends. It is a little bit of a struggle to determine how much is the right amount of digital connection. I have compromised to allow a little more screen time for them, than my typical preference is, praying that this is all temporary and over soon; making way for a little more social freedom and more of the warm weather to enjoy time outside together.

My husband and I are both able to work from home. We have tried to make the most of our time together as a family, as we complete projects or spend time planning activities or bake delicious desserts. With every day possible, we have been outside in the yard (raking, picking up sticks, cutting down tilted trees, stacking wood) or playing catch with our dogs, or hiking a new trail together as a family. It would turn out that this time at home was an unforeseen blessing, as we lost our Maya dog to cancer, very unexpectedly in the midst of it all. Our dogs are a part of our family, and losing Maya so young and so unexpectedly has been intense for all of us. We have experienced loss, but not from the things that have brought fear to the lives of so many at this time. Little changes have helped us to cope.

It will be interesting to see what we will continue to do in these "new" ways, mindfully considering what we have gained from this time, as things shift back to a more typical social model. This weekend's psalm is beautiful and perfect in God's time. "Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in You!" I pray that you have been at peace during this time, and able to surrender your trust to God. Let us thank God in advance for the mountains he will move on our behalf!

Have my troubles kept me from having faith in Jesus? Do I trust him to walk with me during this difficult time? Have I asked for help?*


**Whoever believes in me will do the works that I do.**







A. Resources for Prayer and Adult Faith Formation will be provided through the website, facebook and parish bulletin publications as resources become available.


