“I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth.” - Jn 14:16-17a



During These Times Of Trouble Turn To God

Jesus makes a difference between the way he has been present to the disciples until then and the way he will be present to them after he leaves them. Jesus will ascend to the Father and will send the Holy Spirit to be with us. Yet, in the farewell speech to his disciples, Jesus was uncompromising when he explained the necessary connection between loving him and keeping his commandments: 'If you love me you will keep my commandments'.

The central commandment of Jesus' teaching was to love God and love your neighbor. The teaching of Jesus provides us with definite instructions for everyday living. It stresses the need for correct & respectful relationships with God and with one another. It teaches us that we cannot separate our relationship with God from our various relationships with other people. We cannot have a vertical relationship with God without also having a horizontal relationship with God through our relationships with our neighbor.

These are very trying times for all people. We are struggling with the fear of losing loved ones to the Coronavirus, the fear of losing our jobs, the fear that we may not be able to feed our family or pay our mortgage or rent. We view things negatively because they are judged to be imposing limitations on our freedom.

This is the time that we should get on our knees and ask the Holy Spirit to open our minds and hearts to trust in God. God is the only answer to these problems. This is the time to love our neighbor and be open to helping them when and where we can.

Fidelity to Jesus' commandments enables us to live freely in the presence of God who cares for us. Contrary to popular opinion, the purpose of Jesus' moral demands is to enable us to appreciate the freedom of living according to God's will. It is not to make our lives miserable. Faithfulness to his commandments is the benchmark of our love for him and, in fact, for ourselves and our neighbor.

The teaching of Jesus offers us clear instructions to enable us to be faithful to God's will. It summarizes what is required in order to live a wholesome life that reflects God's truth and beauty. Its purpose is to rid our lives of selfishness and self-centeredness so that we can learn to put God and other people first, and ourselves last.

When our consciences are formed by Jesus' teaching, we know the difference between right and wrong. Living according to his teaching ensures genuine happiness in this life and eternal happiness in heaven. Open up your heart and let God lead us through this difficult time.






Dcn Dan shares a story he wrote his children when they were younger. This story takes on new meaning as he reflects on the importance of community and looking forward to coming together again in worship.



4. Growing in Faith: We will offer resources for our parish communities as we focus on growing our faith through this unique situation. As people of faith we put our hope in Jesus Christ.

A. Resources for Prayer and Adult Faith Formation will be provided through the website, facebook and parish bulletin publications as resources become available.

B. Faith Formation classes for Children and Youth will be canceled for the remainder of the year. We hope this will be a time for our families to grow in prayer together. The faith formation staff will provide resources for families twice a week. Families Growing in Faith resources will include information and activities on a new theme each week. Family Gospel Time resources will provide age specific resources to reflect on the Mass and Sunday Gospel each weekend.

Families will be notified of dates for the Sacraments once restrictions on gathering for Masses have been lifted. Confirmation preparation is postponed until further notice.




