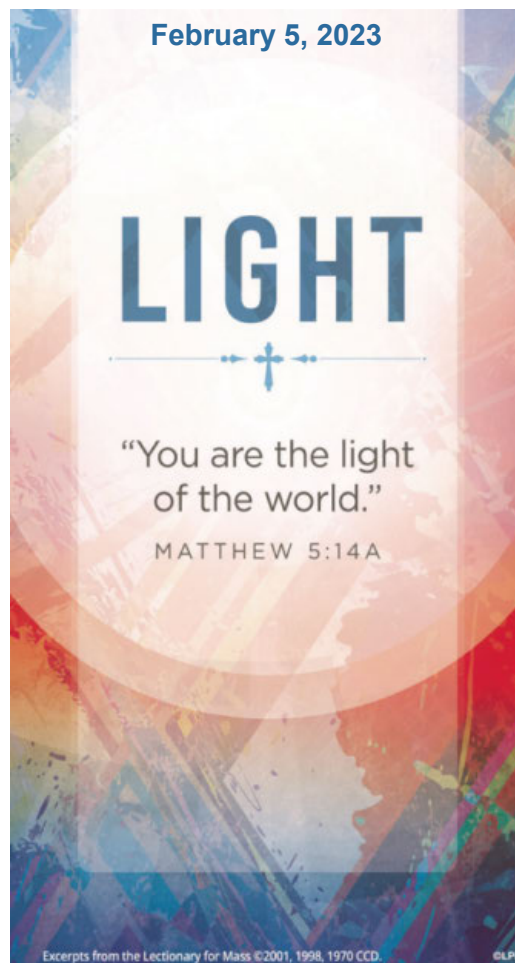

Blessing of Throats

In conjunction with the Feast of St. Blaise (Feb 3) we will be blessing throats at all Masses on 2/4 and 2/5. Some time ago, Fr. William Saunders shared an important insight on this blessing in a column for the *The Arlington Catholic Herald*.

He wrote, "*While we invoke St. Blaise for his protection against any physical ailment of the throat, we should also ask his protection against any spiritual ailment — profanity, cursing, unkind remarks, detraction or gossip. St. James reminds us, 'If a man who does not control his tongue imagines that he is devout, he is self-deceived; his worship is pointless' (1:26) and later, 'We use [the tongue] to say, Praised be the Lord and Father'; then we use it to curse men, though they are made in the likeness of God. Blessing and curse come out of the same mouth. This ought not to be, my brothers!' (3:9-10). Therefore, may St. Blaise protect us from all evil, physical and spiritual, which may attack the throat.*"

I encourage you to consider this as you seek this blessing on Feb 4/5.

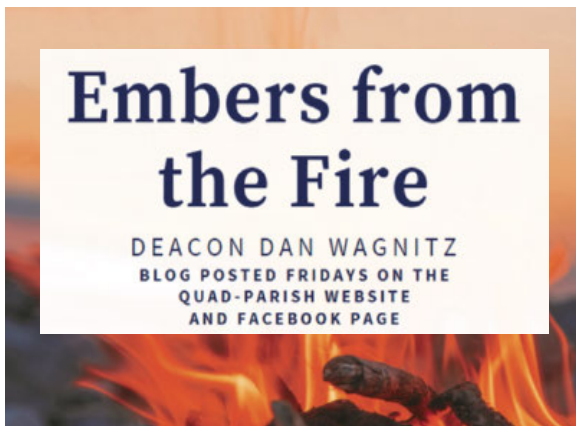

The Way of the Beatitudes

The Gospel of the Beatitudes from Matthew is a very familiar one to us. We have heard it proclaimed many times and also sung it often in the song "Whatsoever You Do."

In this passage from the Gospel, Jesus uses his authority to bless us, teach us and set us free. Will we allow Him to lead us? Are we open and willing to follow Him? Let us open our hearts for Him to show us His way. Let us walk this path of the Beatitudes with Jesus.

Blessed are the Poor in Spirit

When we are satisfied with what we have, not desiring the things we see at stores, on-line and in the homes of others we are blessed. We need to be empty before we can be filled. If we already have too much clutter, there is no room for new spiritual riches and grace.

Blessed are They Who Mourn

When we mourn our loved ones and try to hold on to joy in the midst of sorrow, we are blessed. We can also mourn our sinfulness and turning away from God. Repentance and sincere sorrow are a type of mourning that can result in joy.

Blessed are the Meek

Blessed are the Merciful

When we realize God has forgiven us multiple times, and we show forgiveness to others, we are blessed. There is never an end to this need to forgive self and others.

Blessed are the Clean of Heart

When we are true to our commitment, whether married, in religious vows, the priesthood or single life, we are blessed. We see and experience God's presence in an innocent, honest and sincere way when we are pure, lovely, admirable, and clean of heart.

Blessed are the Peacemakers

When we respect, honor & do not find fault with others, we are blessed. We can also live as peacemakers by being mediators, intercessors or go-betweens.

Blessed are You when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me.

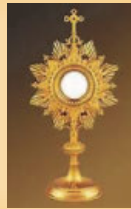

Every attempt will be made to have the Quad-Parish and Faith Formation Office open, but please call before coming since we may get in late or leave early. 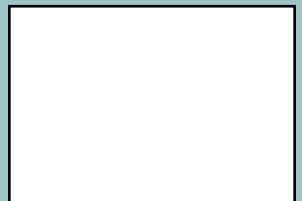
