
WALK TO MARY United in Step from Shrine to Shrine

An Easy Stewardship Opportunity St. Joseph Parking Lot Update

The 12th Avenue parking lot replacement at St. Joe's cost the parish an additional \$28,700 due to unexpected excavating work that needed to be done. We are still accepting parking lot donations to help recover the \$28,700. Cur-



rently, there is \$2,143.43 in the parking lot account which will go toward the \$28,700. Donations continue to come in through the donation canisters at the church entrances and through generous donations by parishioners.

Severe Weather Notice

For safety reasons, if the Green Bay schools (GRACE, public, etc.) are closed or have a 2 hour delay due to bad weather, there WILL NOT be a morning Mass that day. We plan to have Saturday and Sunday Masses as scheduled; however, if there is severe weather, one or more weekend masses may be cancelled. Feel free to call Carol at 920-606-3206 to check on weekend mass availability. Be very conscientious and use your best judgment before coming out for Mass in inclement weather. Your safety is of utmost importance and we cannot guarantee that parking lots will be cleared. If schools are closed due to weather, the Faith Formation Center, Hope Center Pantry and Love Life will be closed. If there is a 2-hour delay, the pantry and Love Life will be open. Every attempt will be made to have the Quad-Parish and Faith Formation Office open, but please call before coming since we may get in late or leave early. Our main concern is keeping everyone safe and we don't want you coming to the office if it is not open. This policy is in effect for the Parish and the Faith Formation Office.



Join us for the movie, The Courageous Heart, Tuesday March 28 at 1:00 pm. in room 105 at Annunciation. This movie is based on the true life story of one woman who saved 2500 Jewish children during the German occupation of Poland during World War II. As a social worker, Irena Sendler had access to the Warsaw Ghetto that made it possible for her to rescue the daughter of a Jewish friend and safely hide the young girl with a Catholic family. Realizing that thousands of children were still in danger, Irena recruited sympathetic friends and co-workers to smuggle children out and place them in safe homes, farms and convents. At great personal risk, she devised extraordinary schemes to sneak the children by Nazi guards, bringing them out in ambulances, suitcases & even wheelbarrows.

Irena was eventually captured by the Gestapo. Even after months of torture, she maintained her silence. Her heroic efforts were honored by a nomination for the Nobel Peace Prize in 2007.




