So, I've been sitting at this computer for the past 45 minutes. The only thing more blank than the screen is my mind. It's late, I have a long week ahead and I need to get this column sent before I can hit the hay. To be

honest, I'm a little frustrated. I am supposed to be someone who can share a message, tell a story or offer some wisdom from a bottomless well of wisdom. It's a lot to expect from someone who isn't particularly worldly, wise or witty. And the most ironic part of it all is that the only pressure that really exists is self-generated. Most people are very clear as to my limits.

I am praying that I receive the words that God wants me to share – no more, no less. "Lord please let me be your voice", I pray. Still, I've got nothing. Google has failed me. I can't find any stories from the week that have some sort of profound meaning. The weather will change four times before the ink of this article dries so that won't be relevant, either. This emptiness is getting very uncomfortable.

I'm now an hour and a half into pacing the floor, starting to type, only to delete a bunch of gibberish. Maybe putting on some music will help...nope! This is getting ridiculous. The clock is ticking. I need to get this done. There are people relying on me. "Hello, Jesus, are you there!!!???"

God has never left me stranded. Surely today is not going to be any different. So, it only makes sense that the message, the lesson, is here with me. I just have to find it. The tv in the other room is now off. The kids are quiet now and the music has been turned down. "Jesus, please try again. Maybe I will hear you better now."

And there it is. Like always, the Spirit has been speaking to me the entire time. The problem has been – again- that I have been trying to do all of the talking (and typing) and haven't put enough effort into listening. The noise of life, the stress of a deadline and the arrogance of over-confidence have prevented me from getting out of the way so God could take over the keyboard. So, this week, let's work to eliminate the noise around us so we can hear the voice of our Savior. So we can begin to truly comprehend the boundless love that God has for each and every one of us.
