

Advent has begun - a time for giving & receiving, and sharing with our brothers & sisters, especially those less fortunate. In the past we participated in a "Jesse Tree" from which we chose an item to give to someone in need.

This year with the approval of our Parish Councils, the Community Life Committee is sponsoring a reverse collection for the residents of Safe Shelter. The shelter serves any family in Brown County in need of emergency housing. Safe Shelter has 13 family rooms, with individual beds serving 2-8 family members. The building was a former credit union located at 2155 Hutson Rd on the west side of Green Bay. Families generally stay 30 days with a maximum of 90 days. During this time residents are assigned a case worker to help them find housing and other needed resources.

For safety reasons, if the Green Bay schools (GRACE, public, etc.) are closed or have a 2 hour delay due to bad weather, there WILL NOT be a morning Mass that day.
