




# Society of St. Vincent de Paul

#### **Severe Weather Notice**

For safety reasons, if the Green Bay schools (GRACE, public, etc.) are closed or have a 2 hour delay due to bad weather, there WILL NOT be a morning Mass that day. We plan to have Saturday and Sunday Masses as scheduled; however, if there is severe weather, one or more weekend masses may be cancelled.

Be very conscientious and use your best judgment before coming out for Mass in inclement weather. Your safety is of utmost importance and we cannot guarantee that parking lots will be cleared.

If schools are closed due to weather, the Faith Formation Center, St. Patrick Food Pantry and Love Life will be closed. If there is a 2-hour delay, Faith Formation, the pantry and Love Life will be open. Every attempt will be made to have the Quad-Parish and Faith Formation Office open, but please call before coming since we may get in late or leave early. Our main concern is keeping everyone safe and we don't want you coming to the office if it is not open. This policy is in effect for the Quad-Parish Office and the Faith Formation Office.
