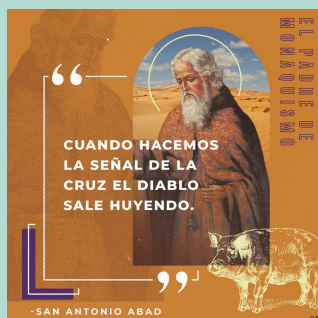

## Let's Celebrate!



In our first reading this week we hear Moses speaking to the Israelites. He tells them that God will send a great prophet from their bloodlines to live among them and to teach them God's Good News. Moses and the many prophets who followed him knew God and were commissioned to share God's message with the people.

In the passage from the letter to the Corinthians that we read this weekend, the writer reminds them that God wants joy and peace for all. He reminds them (and us) that this complete and pure happiness can only be found in God. The writer does not condemn earthly things. Rather, he reminds the readers that life must be lived in the right order, with one's priorities being God first and foremost. Failure to do so can lead to sadness, anxiety and struggle. The message is not heavy-handed. It is not a matter of God being jealous or selfish. It is, rather, a statement of how the world works, how life works.

In the Gospel story for this weekend, we find Jesus in the synagogue. He is teaching those present with unmatched charisma, wisdom and truth. It became clear that Jesus was someone special. Even the evil spirit recognized, without a doubt, that God was in its presence.

Sacred Scripture and our Catholic Tradition provide us with such a treasure of insight into how much God loves us, what God wants from us and how God has shown us the way to true and complete happiness. All we have to do is learn & accept God's truth.



This weekend is the start of Catholic Schools Week. It is a local and nationwide effort to celebrate and promote Catholic education. Catholic schools have played such an important part in so many of our lives and they still do today. Without a doubt, a strong argument can be made that the youth of today may be the generation that needs Catholic schools more than any before it. Catholic school education, especially in our area, has a well-earned reputation and history of teaching students to meet and exceed high academic standards. Perhaps even more importantly, they are a place where children meet and begin to build a relationship with Jesus.

In Catholic schools, teachers and students are offered a safe place to express their love for God and to learn how to love one another in a special and unique way. Catholic schools allow kids to learn right from wrong through the direct teaching of Jesus. In Catholic schools, the Father, the Son and Holy Spirit are not just invited to be part of the community but to lead it every minute of every day.

I suspect many of you spent some of your youth in a Catholic school. This week is a great opportunity to reflect on the many lessons that we learned there, a time to give thanks to all who supported us in our early spiritual journeys and to consider what we can do to support Catholic education for generations to come. We have been blessed and owe it to our benefactors and to our kids to pass those blessings on.
