

#### **CORRECTIONS**

In the 2022-2023 Parish Annual Report for St. Joseph the number of Registered Families was incorrectly reported as 472. The correct number is 328. At the end of the 2022-'23 fiscal year there were 328 families registered with St. Joseph parish. My apologies for the inaccurate information.

An observant parishioner found another error in the report. The "Contributing Units" were also mis-reported in one section. On page 3 they were listed as 207. In the chart on page 5 they were reported as 136. The correct number of "Contributing Units" (defined as contributing \$100+ for the year) for FY 2022-2023 was, in fact, 136.

Both of these errors resulted in mistakenly copying St. Jude's numbers. The remaining numbers in the parish profile section have been verified & are correctly reported. *Dcn. Bill*

know that isn't true but it still might feel like it, right?



## **Diocesan News**

The Diocese of Green Bay has come out with new guidelines for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

EMOHC are to be appointed by the Diocesan Bishop. For this to take place several things will need to happen.

To serve as EMOHC, you must be a catholic in good standing, be at least 16 years old, fully initiated, you participate regularly in the celebration of the Sunday Eucharist and finally be a registered member of the parish in which you are commissioned. Upon approval by the Office of the Vicar General, the EMOHC will be appointed for a five (5) year term, renewable for one additional five (5) year term.

In the back of each church, from 2/24 until 3/10 there will be a signup sheet available for you to register. The week of 3/11 names will be submitted for final approval by the bishop.





In January we served 398 families at the Hope Center Pantry which expands to a total of 1400 people when you factor in all of the people in each client household. Here are a couple "success stories" from the Hope Center Pantry in January...

January 17, 2024 was a below zero freezing cold Wisconsin day. But that didn't stop Lois Mauermann and Terri Lewis from the Brown County Community Women's Club, Inc. (BCCWC)! They filled up their vehicles and delivered to the Pantry: 1 large box and 41 bags of food. Plus, they also donated 17 birthday bags and \$45 cash. You might wonder what the source was of so many amazing items... They had about 100 very generous ladies attend their January 2024 monthly meeting where they did a food drive on behalf of the Hope Center Pantry. Prior to the meeting, they shared the Hope Center Pantry's "most needed items" off of our website. We have deep gratitude for this substantial donation and what it means to our Pantry clients!

On January 24, 2024, we got a call from our Pantry neighborhood grocery store, Save A Lot. They had 33 bags of food donated through their 6th annual "Bags for a Brighter Holiday" collection. This is a nationwide food donation program that Save A Lot does. The purpose is to support local communities in which each Save A Lot store operates by donating much-needed, high-quality food to local charities fighting hunger. Customers could purchase pre-assembled bags of food for \$4.99 as they're checking out at the register. Each bag is stocked with private label and brand name food items, including pasta, stuffing mix, canned beans and other pantry staples from Save A Lot. The Hope Center Food Pantry has partnered with Save A Lot for over two years now to purchase pre-paid gallon milk voucher cards to distribute to our Pantry clients. This allows our clients to get whatever fresh milk they prefer when they need it. Another great example of two organizations working together for the good of those that need a bit of extra help!
