


There will be a Mass with Anointing of the Sick on Thursday, March 21st, Annunciation Church at 12pm. All are welcome!



Diocesan News

The Diocese of Green Bay has come out with new guidelines for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

EMOHC are to be appointed by the Diocesan Bishop. For this to take place several things will need to happen.

To serve as EMOHC, you must be a catholic in good standing, be at least 16 years old, fully initiated, you participate regularly in the celebration of the Sunday Eucharist and finally be a registered member of the parish in which you are commissioned. Upon approval by the Office of the Vicar General, the EMOHC will be appointed for a five (5) year term, renewable for one additional five (5) year term.

In the back of each church, from 2/24 until 3/10, there will be a signup sheet available for you to register. The week of 3/11 names will be submitted for final approval by the bishop. PLEASE take time to enter your information on the signup sheet.

Reporting Sexual Abuse

If you know of an incident of sexual abuse, of a person who is <u>now under the age of 18</u>, by a priest, deacon, employee or volunteer, please <u>immediately</u> call the civil authorities and then the diocese.

If the person was abused as a minor but is now an adult, please contact Office of Safe Environment Diocese of Green Bay, 920-272-8174 or 1-877-270-8174.

We always encourage you to report the incident to local civil authorities. You matter to us - there is hope!
