**“The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.”** (John 12, 23)

On this 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent, St. John the Evangelist brings us to an incident during the last days of Jesus' Public Ministry just before the Jewish Passover. There were some Greeks who were proselytes to Judaism approached Philip saying: "Sir, we wish to see Jesus." Philip, in turn, went to Andrew and they both went and told Jesus. These Greeks were just so eager to see and know Jesus which is in every person's heart. This was the moment Jesus revealed his saving mission: **“The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified.”** His hour of glorification will pave the way to his passion and death on the cross.

While the Paschal Mystery draws near, we're invited to immerse ourselves spiritually into the upcoming Holy Week starting Palm Sunday towards the celebration of Easter. We're encouraged to put ourselves in Jesus' sandals as we circle back into the mystery of His crucifixion, death and resurrection not as tourists but as his disciples on board accompanying Him on the road to Calvary and to the Resurrection. Just like his disciples, we prepare to face the horrible suffering Jesus went through in order for us to share in His victory.

Jesus compared Himself to this image: **“Unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and die, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.”** (Jn.12, 24) He himself is the grain of wheat which has split open to bring much fruit to others. It is by dying on the cross that Jesus was able to bear fruit down through the centuries. It wasn't enough for Jesus to become man like us. In order for us to be fully redeemed, Jesus had to be killed and be buried proving that he was human. But when Jesus rose from the dead, He was, indeed, the Son of God!

His triumph of love was manifested proving that love is stronger than death. Let this last leg of our Lenten journey bring us closer to Jesus asking Him: **“Jesus, what do you want us to do with you and for you?”**

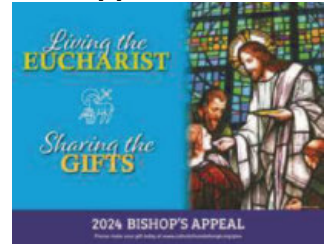

### Are you taking advantage of this IRS Option?

QCDs (Qualified Charitable Distributions) allows individuals age 70½ and older to make tax-free donations directly from an IRA to a qualified charity (for example St Joseph Parish) potentially satisfying all or part of their annual RMDs (Required Minimum Distributions). QCDs don't count as income—meaning you can't deduct the contribution on your tax return; they have already reduced your income by that amount—but the tax benefits could outweigh those of donating cash or other assets to charity. 
