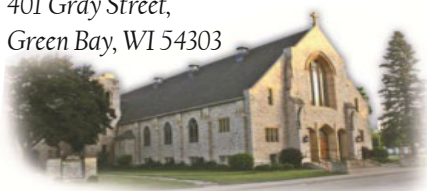

Companions of Prayer - by Sr. Jan

Bishop Morneau wrote a wonderful book called "Living Prayer" with a chapter on Nine Prayer Companions. After reading this chapter, I began reflecting on companions that are with me as I pray. These companions are not all people, as Bishop Morneau shared in his book. The 7 companions of mine are the things that help me pray daily, pray fervently and stay focused.

First, I rise early when the world and the convent is quiet. Peace fills the prayer place. The Time for prayer varies for different people. Being a morning person, I like to begin my day with prayer. If prayer does not begin my day, my day seems off.

Second, a comfortable Chair in my room is important for me. Over the years it has been different chairs, depending on where I was living and working. Some people prefer to pray in chapel. I like the privacy of my room with less distractions and a comfortable chair.

Third, a Cup of coffee next to me is a must. After rising and dressing I head to the kitchen to make a cup of coffee. Sipping it soothes the soul. Over the years caffeinated coffee has changed to half and half because my heart requires less caffeine.

Fourth, Prayer books are helpful. I use books with the readings of the day and commentaries to prepare for Mass and focus on the Scriptures. It helps to center me on the Gospel. I have been trying to come up with a "Word of the Day" to help bring me back to the morning prayer time, as I live each day.

Fifth, People are with me as I pray. My Sisters in my Franciscan community, my family, my friends, our parishioners are with me in spirit as I pray. We Sisters pray the Divine Office each morning and evening. These same people are with me. We often include petitions aloud as requests or needs are made known to us.

Sixth, a Notebook is helpful for jotting thoughts, feelings, quotations and blessings or ideas to refer to later, helping growth in prayer.

Seventh, I have Images or Objects to help me pray. The list is too long so I will talk about these objects, images, and treasures in my next column. Please stay tuned.

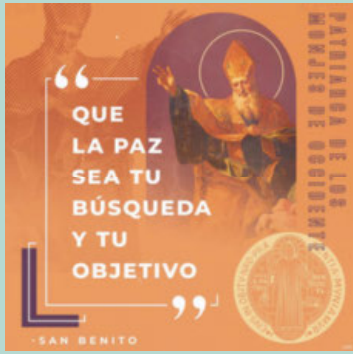

Summer Workshops for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

All parishioners who serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Communion are required to take one of these courses by the end of 2024.

Beginning in June, the Office of Divine Worship, in partnership with parishes throughout the Diocese, is offering a second round of Liturgical Ministry training for parish ministers on the Vicariate level. These workshops will focus on training those who already serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as well as those who wish to begin volunteering in this ministry. Below is the link to register; please forward this email to anyone who is currently serving as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion or anyone who has expressed interest in being one!

Important: Registration for these workshops is required.

Unlike other lay liturgical ministers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to be commissioned for this ministry by the Bishop. This commissioning is preceded by proper and sufficient spiritual, theological, and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. This formation is ordinarily provided by the Office of Divine Worship in partnership with the parish.

These courses will be the same as those offered last Fall; additional enrichment courses will be offered in 2025 for those who wish to learn more.

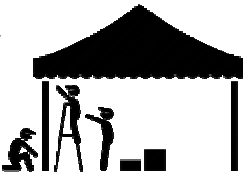

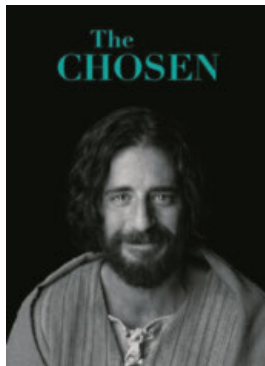

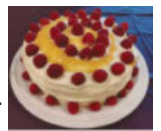
