

QCDs (Qualified Charitable Distributions) allows individuals age 701/2 and older to make tax-free donations directly from an IRA to a qualified charity (for example St Joseph Parish) potentially satisfying all or part of their annual RMDs (Required Minimum Distributions). QCDs don't count as income—meaning you can't deduct the contribution on your tax return; they have already reduced your income by that amount —but the tax benefits could outweigh those of donating cash or other assets to charity. 

Good To Know

Dear Parishioners,

If you or a family member is ever in the hospital, please know that you can call the parish directly to let us know. Often times we are unaware of parishioners who are in the hospital and a call to the Quad Parish office would help us in knowing this. Changes in regulations protecting patient confidentiality are in effect at all hospitals. Even when the hospital asks if they may notify us of your admission and you answer "yes", it is still helpful if you or a family member notifies us directly, especially if someone needs to receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Due to HIPPA regulations the hospitals are not able to notify us of a patient's condition, which is why your help in letting us know directly would be very helpful. You can also call the Pastoral Care Department at any hospital to notify us on your behalf. .

Article 1421 in the Catechism of the Catholic Church states: The Lord Jesus Christ, physician of our souls and bodies, who forgave the sins of the paralytic and restored him to bodily health, has willed that his Church continue, in the power of the Holy Spirit, his work of healing and salvation, even among her own members. This is the purpose of the two sacraments of healing: the sacrament of Penance and the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

Summer Workshops for **Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion**

All parishioners who serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Communion are required to take one of these courses by the end of 2024.

Beginning in June, the Office of Divine Worship, in partnership with parishes throughout the Diocese, is offering a second round of Liturgical Ministry training for parish ministers on the Vicariate level. These workshops will focus on training those who already serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as well as those who wish to begin volunteering in this ministry. Below is the link to register; please forward this email to anyone who is currently serving as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion or anyone who has expressed interest in being one!

Important: Registration for these workshops is required.

Unlike other lay liturgical ministers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to be commissioned for this ministry by the Bishop. This commissioning is proceeded by proper and sufficient spiritual, theological, and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. This formation is ordinarily provided by the Office of Divine Worship in partnership with the parish.

These courses will be the same as those offered last Fall: additional enrichment courses will be offered in 2025 for those who wish to learn more.


