- The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe
- The following celebrations may distribute the Precious Blood at the discretion of the Pastor:
 - First Holy Communion (First Communicants Only)
 - Wedding Mass (Bride and Groom Only)
 - The Mass celebrating the patronal feast of the parish
 - The anniversary Mass celebrating the dedication of the parish



Summer Workshops for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

All parishioners who serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Communion are required to take one of these courses by the end of 2024.

Beginning in June, the Office of Divine Worship, in partnership with parishes throughout the Diocese, is offering a second round of Liturgical Ministry training for parish ministers on the Vicariate level. These workshops will focus on training those who already serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as well as those who wish to begin volunteering in this ministry. Below is the link to register; please forward this email to anyone who is currently serving as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion or anyone who has expressed interest in being one!

Important: Registration is required.

Unlike other lay liturgical ministers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to be commissioned for this ministry by the Bishop. This commissioning is proceeded by proper and sufficient spiritual, theological, and practical preparation to fulfill their role with knowledge and reverence. This formation is ordinarily provided by the Office of Divine Worship in partnership with the parish.

These courses will be the same as those offered last Fall; additional enrichment courses will be offered in 2025 for those who wish to learn more.

In April we served 327 families at the Hope Center Pantry which expands to a total of 1,164 people when you factor in all of the people in each client household. So far in 2024, we have registered 238 new clients at the Pantry. Word continues to spread about our mission!

Here are a couple "success stories" from the Hope Center Pantry in January...

HSHS St. Vincent Hospital and HSHS St. Mary's Hospital Medical Center's mission committee collected noodles during Lent. They called this "Oodles of Noodles!" In April, Bonnie, Manager of Mission Integration and Spiritual care delivered a carload full of noodles and pasta sauce. This is exactly what the pantry was in dire need of! Imagine our excitement when Bonnie showed up with TWO large carts full of these items. What a gift these foods are for our Pantry clients!

Alicia, Network partnership and Eat Well for Life Coordinator at Feeding America of Northeast Wisconsin recently delivered to the pantry \$1,000 in grocery gift cards to use at Mason Brothers' Red Owl, a local grocery store near the pantry. This money was allotted from the Give BIG Green Bay 2024 campaign back in February that raised \$50,111 for Feeding America of Northeast Wisconsin. This gives us the freedom to purchase items that our Pantry is most in need of. We feel so fortunate to be the recipients of these gift cards!

What do you get when you combine troops of Boy Scouts and a dozen committed volunteers? Answer: A well-stocked Hope Center Pantry of course!!!! Saturday, April 27th was the Bay-Lakes Council, Boy Scouts of America 36th annual "Scouting for Food" drive. The bags with suggested food items to donate were dropped off by the Boy Scouts the previous weekend. Then, all of the food was collected by the Boy Scouts in the morning and dropped off at Lambeau Field to be distributed to participating Pantry's in Brown County. The Hope Center Pantry was the recipient of three full "totes" of food. That's approximately 3,000 pounds of food! There were twelve of our volunteers waiting eagerly at the Pantry to help unload, sort and store the food when it arrived. It only took about 75 minutes to complete all of this! The proverb "Many hands make light work!" is true. We are so blessed to have the Boy Scouts doing this event each year to allow our Pantry to help those in our local community that can use some assistance with their grocery costs!




