Visiting Misionary Priest - June 29 & 30

Br. Ayub Mwenda OFMConv will be speaking at the weekend's masses about the work his order is doing to spread the Gospel throughout the world.

Br. Ayub is originally from Kenya. His Franciscan journey has taken him to Tanzania, Zambia (studied for four years), Poland (studied for five years) and as a missionary in Ecuador where he served for two years. Br. Ayub now serves as a food pantry manager at Mary Mother of God Parish in Chicago, IL. He has also ministered at the Basilica of St. Josaphat in Milwaukee, WI and at the shrine of St. Maximillian Kolbe (Marytown) in Libertyville, IL.

Br. Ayub speaks English, Swahili, Polish and Spanish. The Conventual Franciscans number about 4,000 friars serving in 70 countries spread over 6 continents. While the Conventual Franciscans are blessed to count many saints in their history, they are perhaps best known for being the order to which St. Maximillian Kolbe, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Joseph of Cupertino and St. Bonaventure belonged.

From your Finance Council: **Are you taking advantage of this IRS Option?**

QCDs (Qualified Charitable Distributions) allows individuals age 70½ and older to make tax-free donations directly from an IRA to a qualified charity (for example St Joseph Parish) potentially satisfying all or part of their annual RMDs (Required Minimum Distributions). QCDs don't count as income—meaning you can't deduct the contribution on your tax return; they have already reduced your income by that amount —but the tax benefits could outweigh those of donating cash or other assets to charity. Check it out with your financial advisor.



La donacion por estos servicios ha sido la misma por mas 3 decadas en las diocesis de Wisconsin. Recientemente cuando los obispos del estado de Wisconsin se reunieron decretaron que los estipendios deben ajustarse para reflejar el tiempo actual.

La nueva estructura del estipendio es el siguiente:

Misas: \$20 Funerales: \$75 Bodas y quinceaneras: \$100

Esta nueva estructura comienza a ser efectiva en Julio 1ro, del 2024. No se aplicara retroactivamente a los que ya hayan pagado el importe correspondiente al anterior escala de honorarios. La nueva estructura aplicara a todas las solicitudes nuevas recibidads a partir del 1ro de Julio del 2024. Como siempre si alguien no puede ofrecer el estipendio, la parroquia estara feliz de proveer el servicio sin tarifa. Tenga en cuenta que cualquier estipendio recaudado se destina a la parroquia en apoyo de su ministerio y los servicios prestados a la comunidad parroquial, no va personalmente al sacerdote.

Updated Stipend & Fee Structure

We are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses, Funerals, Weddings and Quinceaneras in the past.

The donation for these sacraments and services has remained the same for over thirty years throughout the Dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time.

The new stipend structure is as follows:

Mass: \$20 Funeral: \$75 Wedding & Quinceanera: \$100

This new fee structure will become effective July 1, 2024. It will not be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1, 2024. As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee. Please know, too, that any stipend money collected goes to the parish in support of its ministry and services provided to the parish community; it does not go personally to the priest. 
