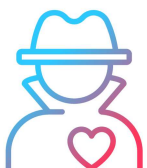

### Fall Fest Chili Recipe

**Chili freezes well so start making yours now!**

2.5 lbs ground beef	2-3 chopped onions
1 chopped green pepper	
2-1 lb cans kidney beans	3-15 oz tomato sauce
3-4 Tbsp chili powder	2 tsp salt
1/4 tsp cayenne pepper	1/4 tsp cumin
2-1 lb cans chopped tomatoes	

Brown meat, onion & green pepper; drain. Add beans and rest of ingredients. Cover & simmer 1½ - 2 hrs.

## Cultivando Reverencia en la Casa de Dios

Nuestra Iglesia es un lugar sagrado donde Cristo habita en la Eucaristía.

"No sabian que ustedes son templos del Espíritu Santo que habita en ti" -1 Corintios 3:16

Esta profunda verdad nos llama a aproximarnos a la Iglesia con profunda reverencia y conciencia. Antes y después de misa, los animamos a cultivar una atmósfera de silencio sagrado. Las instrucciones generales del Misal Romano enfatizan esta práctica para preparar nuestros corazones para alabar y mantener una actitud de gratitud después.

Sin embargo, muchas veces olvidamos el impacto que nuestras acciones pueden tener en aquellos que están a nuestro alrededor y que están buscando un momento de reflexión en silencio. Comportamientos comunes inadvertidamente pueden perturbar a otros incluyendo:

- Participar en conversaciones ruidosas o reírse.
- Usar teléfonos celulares, textear o usar las redes sociales.
- Dejar a los niños correr o jugar de manera ruidosa en las bancas.
- Sonido de bolsas o abrigos.
- Llegar tarde o irse temprano de manera disruptiva.

Estas acciones, aunque no sean intencionalmente irrespetuosas, pueden hacer difícil de manera significativa para otros la habilidad para rezar y preparar para el Sagrado Sacrificio de la Misa.

"Cuando tu rezas a Dios con salmos e himnos, deja que lo que está en tu mente esté en tu voz" San Agustin

Abstenerse de conversaciones casuales y mantener comportamiento de oración, honramos la presencia de Cristo y respetamos a nuestros compañeros feligreses que necesitan un momento de reflexión en silencio.

Esta poderosa imagen debería de inspirarnos a comportarnos con la mayor reverencia en la casa de Dios.

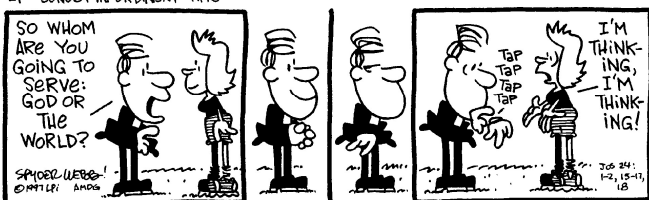

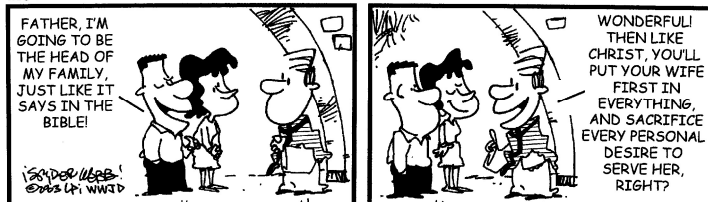

In July we served 431 families at the Hope Center Pantry and registered 78 new clients at the Pantry. Increasing food prices are finding many needing the help of our Pantry to feed their families!

We thought we'd share a couple uplifting stories about how the youth continually comes through for the Pantry... Is high school girls' soccer a competitive sport in Green Bay? It most certainly is! When those ladies are on the field, they are there to win!!! But, there is a common purpose that brings the Green Bay Notre Dame Academy and Green Bay Southwest High School girls soccer teams working together. That cause is the Hope Center Pantry! It is a long time tradition that these two teams have a friendly competition to see who can assemble the most birthday bags. Earlier this summer, the two teams delivered 95 birthday bags to the Pantry. These bags were filled with a cake mix, frosting, birthday candles and an age appropriate gift. When our clients come to the Pantry, they are asked if anyone in their household, age 10 and under, is having a birthday that month. If the answer is "Yes!", they are given a birthday bag based on the child's gender and age. Our Pantry clients light up at the thoughtfulness behind this gesture. It is uplifting to see our local teens unite and go above and beyond for their community! Also this summer, West De Pere Middle School dropped off two large boxes and two bags of food that they collected for the Hope Center Pantry. What a generous gesture this was. Just recently a group of very sweet boy's from St. Norbert's bible school dropped off 100 bags of snack mixes that they made up. The Pantry clients loved them! We love to see our youth doing kind things for their community!

Please continue to pray for our volunteers that help out at the Pantry and our Pantry clients that face food insecurity every day.

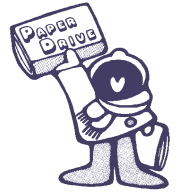
