In August we served 493 families at the Hope Center Pantry and registered 109 new clients. Our economy is having a negative impact on our clients who struggle daily with financial stress.

Recent Pantry Stories: How can anyone not smile when you see the youth of our area doing something out of the goodness of their hearts? Back on August 1st five sweet boys from Old St. Joe's bible school (St. Norbert Parish) stopped by the Pantry and dropped off 100 bags of snack mixes that they had made up just for us! Our Pantry clients were so appreciative when these were distributed.

Besides taking away your childhood teeth as you outgrow them, have you ever wondered what else the tooth fairy does? Well, let us inform you! On June 24th a HUGE box arrived with 100 "America's Tooth Fairy" kits (a.k.a. Smile Guardian Resource kits) inside. Each kit had so many nice pieces that we can distribute to our clients that have young children. Each kit contained a toothbrush, toothpaste, dental health brochure with oral health tips for the entire family and an Action Hero activity booklet. Thank you Patterson Dental Foundation SO VERY MUCH for putting together such a nice package to promote dental health!

On July 23rd, the Hope Center Pantry was elated that the Green Bay Elks Lodge #259 donated \$1,200 to purchase needed items for the Pantry.

How can you help? Not many of you are aware of the "dry spell" that impacts the Pantry each year between Easter and Thanksgiving. Basically from May 1 – Nov. 1, monetary and food donations to the Pantry take a big hit. If you're wondering how to help, check out the Hope Center Pantry website (<https://hopecentergb.com/hope-center-pantry/>) to find our list of most needed items. Also, to all you gardeners out there! If anyone has any clean garden produce they would like to donate to the pantry, you can drop it off Monday through Wednesday from 1-3 pm. 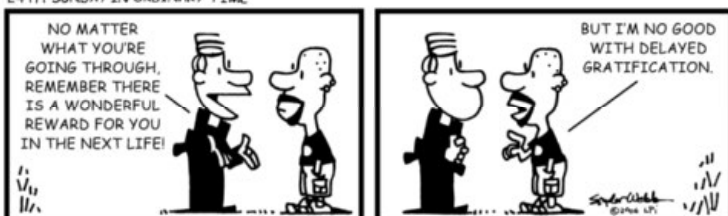

### Are you taking advantage of this IRS Option?

QCDs (Qualified Charitable Distributions) allows individuals age 70½ and older to make tax-free donations directly from an IRA to a qualified charity (for example St Joseph Parish) potentially satisfying all or part of their annual RMDs (Required Minimum Distributions). QCDs don't count as income—meaning you can't deduct the contribution on your tax return; they have already reduced your income by that amount—but the tax benefits could outweigh those of donating cash or other assets to charity. Check it out with your financial advisor.
