

United Way is again organizing a citywide diaper drive in October, which our Love Life ministry benefits from. Although the United Way diaper drive helps with a large supply of diapers, it is not enough to help us through the entire year.

Collection boxes have been placed at each parish. Diaper donations placed in these boxes will go directly to the west side Love Life. Especially size 4, 5, and 6 diapers are needed. 

From your Finance Council: Are you taking advantage of this IRS Option?

QCDs (Qualified Charitable Distributions) allows individuals age 70¹/₂ and older to make tax-free donations directly from an IRA to a qualified charity (for example St Joseph Parish) potentially satisfying all or part of their annual RMDs (Required Minimum Distributions). QCDs don't count as income—meaning you can't deduct the contribution on your tax return; they have already reduced your income by that amount —but the tax benefits could outweigh those of donating cash or other assets to charity. Check it out with your financial advisor.
